Rochester Cathedral Anglo-Saxon Workshop

As a part of our History topic, we are pleased to inform you that we have been able to book an Anglo-Saxon workshop at Rochester Cathedral with an experienced historian, who will teach and immerse our children into what life was like in the Anglo-Saxon period.

These workshops will take place on the following dates:

Copperfield – Tuesday 26th November 2024 10am-11am Wickfield – Thursday 28th November 2024 10am-11am

Trotwood – Thursday 28th November 2024 11am-12pm

We believe this experience will provide a valuable, hands-on experience that supports the children's history learning this term. The cost of this experience is **£2.80 per child** and should be paid, via ParentMail, by Thursday 21st November 2024. If we don't receive enough payments to cover the experience, then the visit will be unable to go ahead.

Please ensure that your child brings a suitable coat that day, as well as a water bottle as we will be walking there and back again. The children's school day will remain as normal and the children must wear school uniform, however they may bring a pair of comfortable shoes to walk in.

The children will be leaving school at 9:15am and return at 11:30am for the 10am workshop, whereas the 11am workshop will leave school at 10:15am and return at 12:30pm.
