Maidstone Museum Visit

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of Year 4's learning for this term, we have been presented with the exciting opportunity to visit the Maidstone Museum on Friday 13th December. This will tie in with our History learning for this term and we will use the opportunity to take a look at and learn about the museum's collection of Ancient Greek artefacts.

This experience will cost £3 per child which will cover the cost of travel. Please return the permission slip and make payment via ParentMail no later than Friday 6th December.

Children should arrive at school at normal time and from there we will walk to Strood Train Station, take the train to Maidstone Barracks and then walk to the Museum, which is only about 10 minutes away. Children will be expected to wear school uniform, however, as they will be on their feet for a lot of the day, they may wear comfortable footwear, such as trainers.

Children will be required to bring their own lunch, so please provide a packed lunch for your child, as well as an extra drink. We kindly remind you not to send your child with anything that may contain nuts and no fizzy drinks. If your child is Free School Meals and would like the school to provide them lunch then please tick the relevant box below.

Children will return from the trip before the end of the school day and can be collected from school as normal.
